

BUILD AMERICA, BUY AMERICA (BABA) DOMESTIC CONTENT CERTIFICATION

Cast Aluminum Traffic Signal Mounting Hardware — Rev. 100126

Conformed to requirements effective for Federal-aid projects obligated on or after October 1, 2026



1. PRODUCTS COVERED

This certification applies to the Skybracket product family for **traffic signal, sign, camera, and detection mounting hardware**, and is issued for use by contractors, distributors, and State and local transportation agencies in documenting domestic content compliance on federally funded infrastructure projects.

Skybracket is a vertically integrated domestic manufacturer. The aluminum used in the covered products is melted and sand cast at **Olson Aluminum Castings, Rockford, Illinois** — Skybracket's parent company — where the castings are also heat treated. Machining, finishing, and final assembly are performed at the Skybracket facility at 2121 15th Street, Rockford, Illinois 61104. Powder coating and aluminum extrusions are performed by qualified domestic suppliers in the Rockford area. No manufacturing operation on the covered products occurs outside the United States.

2. CERTIFICATION OF COMPLIANCE

Skybracket certifies that the products in Section 1 satisfy the Buy America domestic content requirements under the Build America, Buy America Act, IJIA Pub. L. 117-58, as implemented at 2 CFR Part 184, OMB Memorandum M-24-02, and 23 CFR 635.410 as amended by the FHWA manufactured products final rule, 90 Fed. Reg. 2932 (eff. Mar. 20, 2025).

- **Classification.** The covered products are cast aluminum assemblies, classified as manufactured products under 2 CFR 184.3 and 23 CFR 635.410. Aluminum is a non-ferrous metal; these are not iron or steel products.
- **Final assembly — 23 CFR 635.410(c)(1)(vii)(A).** For Federal-aid projects obligated on or after October 1, 2025, the covered products are manufactured in the United States, with final assembly at the Rockford facility identified above.
- **Domestic component cost — 23 CFR 635.410(c)(1)(vii)(B).** For Federal-aid projects obligated on or after October 1, 2026, the cost of the components of each covered product that are mined, produced, or manufactured in the United States exceeds 55 percent of the total cost of all components.
- **Federal assistance outside the FHWA program.** For infrastructure projects funded by other awarding agencies, the covered products meet the corresponding manufactured product standard at 2 CFR 184.4(a)(2) and 184.6.

This certification solely addresses the Buy America domestic content requirements under the Build America, Buy America Act for the products described in Section 1. This is not a certification, representation, or warranty regarding any customer or project-specific requirement, specification, funding condition, or awarding agency determination which may vary by product and agency. Nothing in this certification creates any warranty or indemnity obligation, express or implied, and this certification does not modify or amend any Olson Aluminum Castings, Ltd. terms and conditions.

3. BASIS OF DETERMINATION AND RECORDS

The percentage above is calculated under 2 CFR 184.6(b), attributing each component's cost to the country in which it was mined, produced, or manufactured. Because the aluminum is melted and cast domestically, the cast aluminum components are domestic from the melt forward. Skybracket maintains for each covered product a bill of materials identifying every component, its cost, and its country of origin, with supporting supplier documentation and mill certifications, available for review by a recipient, contractor, or awarding agency on written request.

4. EFFECTIVE PERIOD AND REVISION CONTROL

Issued as Rev. 100126, superseding all prior Skybracket Buy America and BABA certifications. Applies to products shipped on or after the date of signature and remains in effect until superseded, withdrawn, or materially changed by Skybracket's supply chain or the governing requirements. Confirm the current revision at time of order.
